

## Emergency Council Meeting December 16, 2021

The Wymore City Council met in open and public session on December 16, 2021, in the Council Chambers. Mayor Milton Pike called the meeting to order at 7:25 PM. Present were Councilpersons Curt Oblinger, Neil VanBoening, Max Allen, and City Attorney Andy Carothers. Council President Sue Sapp was absent. Notice of the meeting was given in advance by posting in three places: Wymore Post Office, Arbor State Pharmacy, and City Office. Notice was given to the Mayor and Council and their acknowledgement of receipt is attached. All proceedings shown were taken while the meeting was open to the public.

Max Allen made a motion to approve the December 15<sup>th</sup> Payroll. Curt Oblinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Max Allen made a motion to approve Ordinance 666 which assigns new boundaries to Wards 1 and 2 as required by law due to the 2020 census. Neil VanBoening seconded the motion. Andy stated that we would need to wave the three readings due to time constraints. Max made a motion to wave the three readings. Neil seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0 to wave the three readings. Andy read Ordinance 666. The motion to approve Ordinance 666 passed 3-0.

The Council set a Special Meeting for December 22, 2021, to approve claims, approve the plans and drawing by Gilmore and Associates, for the Downtown Parking and Sidewalk Project. Andy stated other items could be added up to Tuesday if need be.

Max made a motion to adjourn.
