

WYMORE PARK BOARD MINUTES 02-13-20207PM

Board Members Present: Bryan Davidson, Angela Meyer, Tim Sedlacek
Absent: Dusty Adams, Aaron Whitwer

Meeting was posted at Wymore City Office, Arbor State Pharmacy, and Wymore Post Office.

Motion by Bryan, 2nd by Tim to approve minutes of last meeting. All approve.

PARK:

Tiffany Henrichs was present to ask about putting in a sand volleyball court somewhere in Arbor State Park. Discussion was had on where it should be put and the cost to the park budget. Tim thought maybe between Rodeo arena and Legion field. Tiffany thought you would need 2 nets that would be approx. \$300 from Outdoor Pro. They would stay up when the park is open and taken down for the winter. Biggest expense would be sand which is approx. \$10 a ton and we would need approx. 55 tons. We will look into more definite pricing and where the park has money to help with this. Everyone thought it was a good idea.

McCandless Park Restroom/Concessions – WBSAF says they have all the money to get started with the project. Demolition of the building, tree removal, and the sewer line to the pit will be taken care of by the City. City will put in panel (Meter & entrance to fuse box) The building will have a kitchen. The fire marshal will be contacted to check requirements to rent out the kitchen. Martin is ready to pour walls when it warms up. Tim has concerns about the fixtures and vandalism. Heavy duty fixtures will be put into the building. Appliances will be purchased by WBSAF. Tim will also check with insurance regarding the building.

Library Foundation wants to put in picture book displays along the sidewalk at McCandless Park. There would be approx. 10-12 displays and the Library Foundation will take care of changing the pages. They are making sure park can maintain around the displays. Park board has no problem with this and the only maintenance from Park Board would be mowing around them.

POOL:

Jacque has 5 employees not returning this year. She is putting applications out until February 29th and will have interviews March 4th. New employees will need lifeguard training.

Portable basketball hoop for the pool is here. The slides will be refurbished in April. Insurance is replacing the turtle slide. It will cost \$1400 to ship the new slide from Wisconsin. Tim will take a trailer and haul the old slide and pick up the new one. We will need to pay him for this, but it will not cost \$1400.

COMMUNITY CENTER:

Replacing the HVAC has been approved from insurance. This was damaged by hail.
Roy Lauby will get it replaced when he can.
