The Park Board met on January 27, 2026 at the Community Center.

Community Center Update:

A \$50,000 grant was approved for replacement of doors and painting

- Tim suggested a single door with a filler panel window
- Lila stated she would prefer a single door for the front
- Out back will stay as double doors
- New colors are TBD
- Starting or waiting for CCCF matching funds was discussed
- We need letters of support from community members and park board members
- Discussion of possibly getting rid of the stage or moving it 20 feet.

Pool Discussion:

- Shannon Burgess will not be returning as manager this year
- Suggestions for a new manager were stated
 - Nicole Stevens was suggested by Kevin, it was stated that we needed to updated the job description before advertising
- Everyone needs to reapply for their position this year
- Consideration of increasing pay was discussed for managers & supervisors – potentially offering Nicole \$18.00/hour IF she took the position. Assistant manager to \$15.00/hour. Increasing lifeguard wages by \$1.00/hour and \$0.25/hour for each returning concession stand employee
- Janet will reach out to other local pools for pay grids
- More discussion was had about managers receiving an extra \$1.00/hour

McCandles Park Discussion:

- City Council put an extra \$10,000 into park board budget to fix McCandles field with red aggregate
- Would take up to \$50,000 to fix all everything – i.e. field, poles, dugouts, etc
- We would need matching grants
